Eligibility:

- Applicant MUST meet the timeline specified in this application
- Applicant must be a current full-time student and maintain a full-time status at Texas A&M University from Austin County (except for last semester graduating Seniors with fewer than full-time status)
- ♦ Applicant must have completed a minimum of 12 hours at Texas A&M
 - Or 12 hours at an accredited college and have been accepted as a transfer student to Texas A&M as a full-time student and maintain full-time status at Texas A&M
- Applicant must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.50
- Applicant must complete the application in its entirety
 - Incomplete applications will not be considered
