- 👉 Applicant **MUST** meet the timeline specified in this application
- 👉 Applicant must be a resident of Austin County
- 👉 Applicant must be accepted and maintain full-time student status at Texas A&M University
- 👉 Applicant must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.50
- 👉 Applicant must complete the application in its entirety
 - Incomplete applications will not be considered
